- a. AB 1712 - Pacheco, Blanca - City of Santa Fe Springs: sale of water utility property.

  - ii. **Jennifer Perez motioned to support the bill. Bill Uphoff seconded the motion. Chris Barajas opposed the bill. The motion passed.**
- b. AB 1941 - Gonzalez, Mark - Organized metal theft.
  - i. Vincent Huynh, representing Mark Gonzalez, gave a presentation on the background of the bill.
  - ii. **Bill Uphoff motioned to support the bill. Bea Dieringer seconded the motion. The motion passed unanimously.**
- c. AB 2529 - Johnson, Natasha - Civil claims: public employees: perjury.
  - i. Attorney Derek Matthews representing, Aleshire & Wynder gave a presentation on the background of the bill.
