- b. SB 828 - Cabaldon, Christopher - Fireworks licenses and permits: disqualifying conditions: local jurisdictions.
- i. Timothy Knox and Shara Murphy, from the office of Senator Christopher Cabaldon, gave a brief presentation on the background of the bill. Dennis Revell from Revell Communications recommend recommendations to the bill.
